As we are on Half Term break for Ash Wednesday this year, we cannot mark the start of Lent with our usual Whole School Service.

Breakfast/Afterschool Club/Wraparound

Parents are reminded that all bookings for the above clubs must be pre-booked onto the Schoolmoney App. For Nursery parents, your sessions must be booked and paid for by Sunday for the week ahead. Breakfast and afterschool clubs must be booked at least the day before your session. If you require an 'emergency' booking, this must be arranged with the school office via telephone. The office will then check your account and if you have credit on your account the booking will be confirmed. However, if your account is in arrears or there are insufficient funds to cover the booking, then the booking will not be taken, and you will be asked to ring back when the arrears are paid, or funds have been applied. School Meals Reception, Y1 and Y2

As a school we offer free school meals to all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Some children in our school prefer to bring in their own lunch, which is another option for the children.

Please can we ask that your child chooses one of the options on offer. We understand that some children have limited diets and need the opportunity to try new foods in an attempt to widen their food intake, which we welcome. However, some are ordering full meals to only eat certain parts and bringing a packed lunch in too. I am sure you can appreciate with the cost-of-living crisis and our recent donations to Teardrops, it is heart-breaking to see so much food go to waste intentionally.

We ask that if your child can, only choose one option either hot school dinners or packed lunch going forward to limit the amount of food being wasted.

We appreciate your understanding in this matter and will be willing to answer questions if you have them.
