Changes to School Meals

All parents will have received an email with a link to register for School Grid regarding the major changes to how your child's school meal is ordered. This new system goes **LIVE** on Friday, 28th March, and meals should be ordered from home prior to this. These changes apply to all year groups. Meals are ordered from home on either a daily, weekly, or monthly basis and are paid for at the time of ordering. If your child is in Reception, Y1, Y2 or entitled to Free School Meals, you still need to order their school meal.

There will be no facility to order a meal through the school office, it must be done prior to attending. This new procedure is being controlled by the local council and not by school. Please make sure you familiarise yourself with the app and make it a routine to order your child's school meal.

Holidays In Term Time

Parents requesting to take their child out of school for a family holiday during term time are now required to complete a Holiday Request Form prior to the holiday.

These forms are available from the school office.
