
#### **Clubs Summer Term**

Starting w/c 21<sup>st</sup> April we will be again running our Football and Gymnastics after school clubs. The clubs will run up to w/c 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025

Football for Y4 to Y6 will start Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April until 7<sup>th</sup> July There will be no club on 5<sup>th</sup> May (Bank Holiday) or 2<sup>nd</sup> June (School Holiday) 8 sessions @ £5 = £40 in total – payable in two instalments

Gymnastics Club will continue Tuesdays. This is for Reception right up to Y6 children. Sessions start on Tuesday  $29^{th}$  April and continue right up to  $8^{th}$  July. 10 sessions @  $\pm 5 = \pm 50 - payable$  in two instalments.

#### **Rainford Youth Council**


